Introduction to the Construction Trades Industry

The construction industry is booming nationwide and has been for nearly a decade. Involved in \$130 billion worth of projects every year, the industry is leading what the provincial government has described as a “golden decade” for the economy in BC, and the number of major construction projects across BC continues to grow to record levels¹.

The Canadian Construction Association President Michael Atkinson said in *Maclean's Magazine* that "there is this belief out there that construction is a dirty, unsafe, no-brainer, dead-end occupation, that's wrong. It takes training - four years after high school, for most specialties - to become a carded tradesperson, and the worker can be making good money. It's not farfetched, he said, for a 25 year old electrician to be earning \$100,000 a year."²



For people skilled with their hands or for those who love to see a finished product at the end of the day, a career in the construction trades can be very rewarding.

Construction Industry Facts

- 1 out of every 17 Canadian workers earns a living in construction³
- Employment in construction reached a record high in 2005 with one million workers⁴
- The Construction Sector Council reported that BC's construction sector will need to recruit an additional 24,000 workers over the next three years (2008-2011)⁵
- Construction employment in BC was up 15.3% in May 2007 compared to the same month the year before⁶
- A shortage of qualified workers is eliminating new growth in construction⁷
- 64% of BC employers in the construction industry reported they were having problems finding enough skilled workers to operate their business at full capacity
- 75% of employers employ people who are taking ongoing apprenticeship or certification training⁸
- It is estimated that a new apprentice in the construction trades today will be earning over \$100,000 per year within the next ten years⁹

Job Outlook

Current economic conditions have slowed growth, but construction is expected to continue to outperform other industries. Governments' fiscal stimulus packages are a key driver in 2009 and 2010. As economic conditions improve, the industry will see the return of private investment as postponed projects are resumed and new major construction projects are announced. As well, many workers are nearing retirement – so the odds are good that the demand for skilled construction workers will remain high.

The Construction Sector Council has created a province-by-province, trade-by-trade labour market forecast for the next nine years (online at: www.constructionforecasts.ca).

Types of Careers

If you're bright, ambitious, energetic and creative, the construction industry has something for you! There are dozens of trades and occupations to choose from. Whether you decide to become a skilled construction worker or a manager, you can potentially earn up to six figures annually.

The construction industry can provide a wide range of work opportunities with varying degrees of training required such as electricians, plumbers, carpenters, labourers, pipefitters, roofers, insulators, bricklayers, tile setters, painters, contractors and supervisors.



Working Conditions

If you enjoy working with people and you want a profession filled with excitement and variety, you can find a satisfying life-long career in the construction industry. While many jobs involve teamwork and a degree of physical strength, working conditions in the construction industry can vary considerably. It may involve working mostly in the outdoors, or indoors in industrial settings. You may be required to work at considerable heights, or work may be cramped and involve moving around in awkward spaces. The best way to find out about working conditions is to talk to industry associations, employers, and employees in the field that interests you.

Wages¹¹

Wage rates vary widely among different industry careers, and even within specific trades and occupations. The best way to find out about wages is to talk to industry associations, employers and employees in the field that interests you. Given the high demand for many trades, wages are often competitive. Following are some examples of average wages for different positions:

- Plumbers and related welders working on federal building projects earn \$25.90 per hour
- Sheet metal workers make \$25.90 per hour
- Pipefitters and steamfitters make \$26.76 per hour
- Roofers make \$21.92 per hour
- Refrigeration and air conditioning mechanics make \$30.65 per hour
- Electricians working on federal construction projects in the Vancouver area earn \$26.20 per hour

Education and Training

The construction industry is an exciting industry and good tradespeople are highly sought after. People can enter the construction industry with a variety of backgrounds. Some enter the industry by finding jobs as labourers, helpers, or apprentices. Others enroll in an apprenticeship program – before or after you finish high school – or one of the many construction-related diploma and degree programs now available at colleges and universities.

Apprenticeships¹²

Apprenticeships are paid, work-based training, usually combined with post-secondary education. Typically about 80-85% of an apprenticeship is made up of work-based training and the other 15-20% is made up of technical training taken in a classroom and shop setting. The length of an apprenticeship can range from one to five years, but most require four years to complete. Many trades, known as the “Red Seal” trades, have nationally recognized certification standards. The credentials of a certified tradesperson who has successfully earned a Red Seal ticket are recognized across Canada.



The work based component of an apprenticeship represents an important commitment between the apprentice and the employer. Apprentices and their employers are required to register their apprenticeship or industry training agreements and to document the work-based training completed. It is up to prospective apprentices to find an employer willing to hire them and commit to their training.

The technical training component of an apprenticeship usually involves spending four to eight weeks per year in a classroom and shop setting. During each level of training, apprentices will study specific subject areas. Examinations typically take place as each level of technical training is completed. Apprentices are responsible for selecting and registering for their technical training, and working with their employers to schedule it at appropriate times. It is important to note that classes fill up quickly, and you are encouraged to register well in advance of when you wish to attend.

Apprentices are responsible for covering a portion of the costs of their technical training, and they are not usually paid during the time they are taking technical training, but they **may** qualify for Employment Insurance benefits.

The Red Seal Program¹³

The Red Seal Program was established to provide greater mobility across Canada for skilled workers. Through the program, apprentices who have completed their training and certified journeypersons are able to obtain a “Red Seal” endorsement on their Certificates of Qualification and Apprenticeship by successfully completing an Interprovincial Standards Examination.

The Red Seal program is administered in each province and territory under the guidance of the Canadian Council of Directors of Apprenticeships (CCDA). It encourages standardization of provincial and territorial apprenticeship training and certification programs. The “Red Seal” allows qualified tradespeople to practice the trade in any province or territory in Canada where the trade is designated without having to write further examinations.



How to Obtain a Red Seal?

In certain trades, holders of provincial and territorial Certificates of Qualification can apply to write an Interprovincial Examination; if successful, they receive a distinctive “Red Seal” which is affixed to their Certificate of Qualification.

An Interprovincial Standards Red Seal can be obtained in the trades designated as Red Seal by:

- Graduating from a recognized provincial or territorial apprenticeship training program
- Obtaining a journeyperson level certificate from a province or territory
- Passing the Interprovincial Standards Examination for that trade

Funding for Training

There are a variety of sources of funding for training available that should be explored, including student loans, grants, bursaries, your bank and/or savings. Further sources of funding may be available for those with an attachment to EI (either currently or within the last three years) or maternity/parental benefits in the last five years.

The Independent Contractors and Business Association offers bursaries for new apprentices, and will even provide Home Depot gift cards for those who maintain high grades.

Another source of funding is Service Canada's Apprenticeship Incentive Grant, available to registered apprentices once they have successfully completed their first or second year of an apprenticeship program in one of the Red Seal trades.

Where Can I Find a Job?

Finding a job is your own responsibility, but there are many helpful resources. Check out the Service Canada Job Bank, our Centre Postings, or make an appointment to see an Employment Advisor. Another very useful approach is to “network”, by making contact with employers and people working in the field you are interested in. A good starting point would be to check out our Employer Directory at the back of this binder.

Kamloops Construction Company Hiring Practices

The Kamloops Work Search Centres conducted interviews with local construction companies to gather information on their hiring practices. This is what we discovered:

Recruitment

- Construction companies seldom advertise for positions
- They generally recruit through word of mouth and dropped off resumes
- They receive two to three calls per week from people looking for work
- There is a shortage in Kamloops of “good experienced workers”

Resumes

- Resumes are required
- Resumes are generally accepted anytime of the year
- It should contain detailed information on your experience, and/or training
- References are required
- Some companies will hold resumes for one year
- Cover letters are not necessary

Required Skills

- Prefer some relevant experience and/or training
- The TRU Apprenticeship Training Course is looked upon favorably
- Companies prefer at least minimum amount of tools and clothing (hard hat, boots, tool belt, etc.)
- Own transportation
- A great attitude and a strong work ethic is important
- Most employers will give new graduates on-the-job journeyman training

Interviews

- Employers want to meet employees in person before they are hired
- Interviews are conducted to get more information on experience and skills

Prepare to Get Hired

Construction tends to be busiest in spring and summer, however most companies will hire throughout the year.

Getting Started in the Industry

- **Spend some time thinking about what type of work you would like to do.**
There is a lot of information available to you – check out the Website section in this binder for some sites that can help you find out about the different occupations available and sites to pinpoint the occupations that you might be best at.
- **If you don't know** for sure what specific trade you would like to work in, consider starting at the “bottom of the ladder” and find out what interests you while you are on the job. Work Futures (www.workfutures.bc.ca) reports that most trades workers begin their careers this way.
- **Talk with others already working in trades positions** and find out what steps they took and what they enjoy about their career. If you would like some tips on doing this, see the handout on *Informational Interviews* in the Employment Handouts bookshelf.
- **Find out what type of education or training you need** to find work in the job you are interested in. See the Website section in this binder for a list of educational facilities.
- **Contact employers directly**, as this is often the best way to find employment in your chosen area. A list of construction contractors for the Kamloops area is at the back of this binder. Ask a staff member for more information.
- **Contact industry associations and unions** for information on training and careers. For example, the Southern Interior Construction Association (SICA) offers training in the construction trades for entry level. See www.sica.bc.ca/index.shtml for more information.



What If's

What if I need to give the employer a copy of my driver's abstract?

If you have a BC drivers' licence, you can get a copy of it free of charge at the Courthouse (455 Columbia Street; 851-3700) or at the driver's training office (937 Concordia Way by TRU; 828-4540). Copies of it can be made at the Kamloops Work Search Centres.

What if the employer needs a copy of my certification?

The Work Search Centres can make photocopies of your certificates, driver's licence and resume.

What if the employer requires that I have my own tools?

Find out what tools are absolutely necessary for you to have. Explore your options – do you know anyone who can lend them to you?

Will the employer let you work without your own tools for a few weeks until you receive your first paycheck?

If you are on Social Assistance, ask a Financial Assistance Worker if there are funds to support you with the purchase of tools. Ask at local employment agencies if there are any funds for a person in this position.

What if I don't have a resume? I have never needed a resume before!

Resumes are becoming the standard way of conveying your skills and experience for all work, including trades occupations. Even though you may not have needed one before, employers state that things have changed. A current polished resume is a vital tool in the work search.

What if I have no way to reach the job site?

Ask neighbors if they are heading in the direction of your worksite and if they can give you a ride. Research local transportation options from buses to taxis. Ask the employer if they have an employee who may be willing to give you a ride, or check out the website www.carpool.ca.

Women in Construction and Trades

Historically, women have not had a huge presence in the construction industry, but that is starting to change. The number of women entering the trades, while still relatively small, is growing (<http://www.bccassn.com/winc.html>). More and more women are enrolling in apprenticeships, and women bring a rich base of natural skills and abilities to these industries. Women in the trades tend to ask more questions about a job, they have good communications skills; they can access smaller spaces, are multi-taskers, are easier on equipment, and are less prone to enter into job site conflicts.



More and more resources and programs are being developed to support women in the trades such as:

- **The Skilled Trades Employment Program for Women**, which is a mentoring network and program for women who have an interest in entering the construction trades as well as those women already active in the industry who may need support in furthering their careers. (www.bccassn.com)
- **National Association of Women in Construction**, which is committed to creating opportunities and business for women-owned construction firms and policy-making executives in the construction industry (www.nawic.org)
- **The Pink Nail Project** is an initiative which raises money to fund bursaries for women entering the trades (www.bccassn.com/winc.html)
