**FOODSAFE** is a comprehensive food safety training course aimed primarily at educating workers in the food service industries

**Foodsafe Level 1** is a training program designed for food service operators, handlers, kitchen & serving staff. Participants learn how to handle and prepare food in a way that protects them and their customers from injury and illness.

**Foodsafe Level 2** is a program for chefs, operators, managers and supervisors. It reviews Foodsafe Level 1 lessons and addresses advanced food safety knowledge and procedures vital to running a safe food service business.

Please note – the fixed costs for the FOODSAFE program are approximately \$15 per student for the Student Workbook and the certificate processing fees. This does not include cost for instruction and fees may vary for the individual course providers.

To be eligible for entry into the FOODSAFE database and issuance of certificates, the course must be taught by a certified instructor and meet the course delivery & exam standards outlined on the FOODSAFE website at <http://www.foodsafe.ca/downloadfiles/FSImpManTrainingStandards.pdf>.

**Replacement Card:** You can order a new one by contacting the Health Authority that services the city in which you received your certificate. Follow the instructions on the website to get the contact information for the appropriate Health Authority

### Does my FOODSAFE certificate expire?

Some employers require a new certificate after a certain period of time. However, at present, most FOODSAFE certificates do not expire. If you received your Level 1 certificate more than three years ago, it is recommended that you take the course again. Having a recent certificate is an advantage when seeking employment.
